“Maryland Is All Right”: General George H. Nye’s Civil War Experience in Maryland With Nick Picerno

Nicholas Picerno is chairman emeritus of the Shenandoah Valley Battlefields Foundation. He serves on the Board of Trustees of the Museum of the Confederacy in Richmond, Virginia and the Lee-Jackson Education Foundation of Charlottesville. He was appointed by the Secretary of the Interior to the National Advisory Board of the Cedar Creek- Belle Grove National Park and is Vice-President of the Lincoln Society of Virginia. He has been researching and collecting the history of the 1st-10th & 29th Maine Infantry regiments for thirty years. A career police chief he is the Chief of Police at Bridgewater College in Bridgewater, Virginia.


